Requirements for spelling and grammar quizzes:

- Underline the spelling word.
- Determine the part of speech for the spelling word as it is used in the sentence.

Example: What is your favorite restaurant?

Noun

Parts of speech:

1. Noun: person, place, thing, or idea

Common noun	Proper 'noun	
Names a general person, place, thing, or idea	Names a specific person, place, thing, or idea	
Not capitalized	Capitalized	
Ex: girl; building; team	Ex: Sue; Empire State Building; Yankees	

2. <u>Verb:</u> action verbs: a word that expresses an action; tells us what the subject is doing (mental or visible)

Examples: working; running; remember; write

3. Adjective: describes a noun or pronoun

Adjectives tell us four things:

Which one? the <u>blue</u> sweater (blue is an adj. describing sweater)

What kind? the old car (old is an adj. describing car)

How many? three flowers (three is an adj. describing flowers)

How much? three cups of flour

4. Adverb: describes a verb, adjective, or other adverb

Adverbs tell us four things:

1. How?

I ran quickly.

2. When?

I swam yesterday.

3. Where?

I walked here.

4. To what extent? I <u>completely</u> understand the topic.

Reminder: Adverbs usually end in "ly"
